



# SUNFLO MAX-128

## Ready-To-Use (Diluted)



Follow directions for use on the concentrate label when applying this product.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:** Alkyl (C<sub>14</sub>, 50%; C<sub>12</sub>, 40%; C<sub>16</sub>, 10%) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride, Octyl decyl dimethyl ammonium chloride, Didecyl dimethyl ammonium chloride, Dioctyl dimethyl ammonium chloride

The product in this container is diluted as directed on the pesticide label.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: CAUTION.** Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed by the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**FIRST AID:** Have product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
